THAR SHE BLOWS!

The spring came in like a lion with a major localized storm that literally tore the roof off the airport! As Pilots, we know that the weather can be an unpredictable thing, and we need to pay attention to it in order to protect our planes and our hangars. Besides normal inspection, maintenance and repair to your hangar and planes, it is part of your lease that you maintain your hangar. Specifically:

3. To maintain the Hangar in sound structural condition and in good repair, and to keep same and the apron contiguous thereto in a clean and neat condition and to keep the exterior in a colour approved by the Owner and Operator. In the event that the Licensee Occupant fails to maintain the Hangar and the apron contiguous thereto as herein required the Owner and Operator may give notice to the Licensee Occupant designating maintenance work required to be done by the Licensee Occupant.



Part of your responsibility and your obligation to your lease is to carry proper approved insurance coverage naming the Airpark as additional named insured.

V The Licensee Occupant shall obtain and keep in full force and effect at all times one or more policies of fire, extended peril and liability insurance which provide, as a minimum, the following coverage:

- 1. Primary coverage insuring the Licensee Occupant and any other party in interest against risk of loss or damage to the Hangar in a face amount sufficient to cover the replacement cost of the Hangar;**
- 2. Comprehensive third party liability in the face amount of not less than ONE MILLION DOLLARS Canadian (\$1,000,000.00 Cdn.). The insurance policy required hereby shall name Burlington Airpark Inc. the Owner and Operator its successors and assigns) as additional named insureds.**

FUELING FLOW— PLEASE!

We are still experiencing some congestion near the pumps. With this considered, there are a few basic rules that should be adhered so that the flow runs smoothly.

- 1) When you arrive in front of the pumps, please start the process right away
- 2) Always ground your plane with the ground wire provided
- 3) Please don't drag the nozzle along the ground when retracting

4) As soon as you are finished fueling, please move your plane to allow others access to the pump.

5) If you experience difficulties with the system, please contact the office

Following these basic rules and courtesy, the system will accommodate everyone with little congestion!
